



ACTIVITY SHEET

"WHEN I GROW UP..." CHATTING ACTIVITY

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Target Audience: Early childhood, preschool
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Here's an opportunity to help young children develop self-awareness, interact with others, demonstrate their understanding, expand their vocabulary, gain new knowledge related to different learning areas, activate their imagination, and practice fine motor skills.

- 1** Set up a "Chatting" mode!
- 2** Start by telling the children why you chose your profession!
Highlight the qualities required to practice it.
- 3** Ask the children what profession they would like to pursue in the future and let them know that they will have to draw themselves and imagine themselves in a future job.
- 4** Ready, set, draw!
- 5** As a group, present the drawings made by the children.
- 6** Start the discussion with questions for everyone!
Here are some suggested questions to ask:
 - What professions have been drawn?
 - Are there any who have chosen the same profession?
 - What qualities do we need to have to be able to do these professions?
 - Are there any work tools or objects that we could add to the drawings to recognize the profession better?

Variant

To explore their interests even further, do the same with **activities, sports, or arts** that they want to pursue in the future or already engage in.

Ideas to promote learning

- **Reading Corner** | Books about professions are featured and read to the children.
- **Dress-Up Corner** | Hats and costumes representing different professions are made available to the children (firefighter hat, construction hat, doctor's kit, etc.).
- **Home Corner** | Accessories are highlighted to explore a few professions (restaurant, veterinary clinic, school, hair salon, etc.).
